

BE PILGRIMS OF HOPE

Pope Francis has announced that the Church will celebrate a Jubilee Year in 2025, with the theme "Pilgrims of Hope," a relevant theme in the present context of the world which is plagued by a profound crisis in hope because we hope for earthly happiness rather than eternal one, and we hope to achieve this by human ingenuity, rather than by the grace of Christ. The Dicastery for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life is inviting all consecrated men and women to participate in the Jubilee of Consecrated Life to be celebrated in Rome from 8-9 October 2025 and nationally in home countries on 2 February 2025. The theme is "Pilgrims of Hope: On the Path of Peace" with a special focus on listening to the cry of the poor, care of creation and solidarity with all our brothers and sisters.

Since our life is a journey from God and tends towards God (NA 1), from our heart to the heart of God, it is a sacred journey, a pilgrimage. We are on a pilgrimage towards our homeland (Heb 13:14). Pilgrimage is a powerful symbol of the itinerant condition of our human existence in this world. Jesus was born as a pilgrim, and from the very beginning until the very end of his earthly life, he always seemed to be on the road or on the verge of moving on with no place on earth to call his home. Jesus' pilgrimage was from the Centre to the geographical and existential peripheries, to the places where the most vulnerable, the poorest and the forgotten are to be found rather than to the Jerusalem temple. Christian pilgrimage means keeping our eyes, minds and hearts fixed on our goal, which is Christ, and set out every day anew. Jesus Christ is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and end.

The Christian existence is a pilgrim existence. It began with Abraham, the father of believers (Gen 12:1), then continued through Moses (Ex. 3:7-8), the Prophets (Is. 6:8; Jer.1:7) Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:4) and finally Jesus gave the apostles the mission mandate, to go and be his witnesses to the ends of the earth (Mt. 28:19; Mk.16: 15; Lk.24: 17; Jn. 20:21; Acts. 1:8). Hope lies in our readiness to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the "peripheries" in need of the light of the Gospel (*EG* 20). In this pilgrimage of life, there are two kinds of people: evangelizing people who care for the copilgrims and worldly people who pass by (*FT* 70), a Good Samaritan and an indifferent bystander. Hope for us and others depends on our daily decision "whether to be Good Samaritans or indifferent bystanders" (*FT* 69). The response is for us to become a neighbour to everyone in need and to recognize that the whole world is our neighbourhood.

The tendency among the consecrated persons today is to exit the way of the pilgrimage and settle down for a secure job, a secure place and a comfortable life. Consequently, they tend to be more inward-looking rather than outward and forward-looking. When we do not come out of ourselves, out of our campuses and reach out to the people, especially people in the geographical and existential peripheries, we turn out to be a worldly person, living for ourselves instead of an evangelizing person. As pilgrims on earth, let us hope for a cosmic human family and journey as fellow pilgrims sharing the same flesh, as children of the same earth which is our common home, each of us sharing with others our uniqueness, our beliefs and convictions and move forward towards the fullness of the Kingdom of God or "a New Heaven and a New Earth" (Rev 21:1).

Alternative Medicine

Rev. Fr. Vijay Payyappilly CMI is providing valuable service to the people of North India through alternative medicine. He serves a minimum of 130 patients every week in various locations such as St. Mary's Hospital Najibabad, Maria Bhavan Nathewaly, Sanjo Bhavan Ghaziabad, and Faridabad. Slum Development Project

A Fruitful 25 Years at Jeevan Dhara Ashram



Rev. Fr. Claudius D' Almeda, the principal and the Parish Priest at Sacred Heart Inter College, Sitapur: enlightened the parents with his










While numerous hymns honour Mother Mary in diverse languages,
