President's Message



Education plays a vital role in the integral development of an individual and the all-round growth of society. The goal of education is to build character, enlarge the heart, expand intellect, and produce a better human person for the nation. The schools are privileged places of personality development. This requires a change in the method of teaching in the school. Suppose a teacher stands in front of 40 students, each one having different strengths, different needs, different gifts, and different dreams and she teaches the same thing in the same way, the teacher may not be able to identify the innate interests and awaken the hidden potentialities in each one. The mere transmission of content as an educational principle is outdated and impoverished because it conceives only an intellectualist mode and the language of the head. Therefore, we need to use the 'language of the mind, of the heart and of the hand.' The teachers must understand that 'the student's mind is not a vessel to be filled but a fire to be kindled.'

Character formation and training in values are of prime importance in the present scenario which is marked by technological development. It has brought about easy access to knowledge, faster development of society, quality of personal life, and better global relationships but it has also increased destructive applications of science and technology, environmental degradation, unethical money accumulation and erosion of fundamental human values. Therefore, the school's effort should be to liberate the students enabling them to be creative, critical and responsible citizens of the country rather than just helping them to maintain the existing system. According to Pope Francis, "education is a dynamic reality; it is a movement that brings people to light." Education should help students transcend individualism, appreciate differences, discover fraternity and be responsible for the environment.

He recognized the family as the primary environment for education and character formation, emphasizing the importance of parents as role models and educators.

Beginning of the new Academic Session

"Well begun is half done." The Carmel family stepped into the new academic session 2024-25 on 18th March 2024 with enthusiasm and dedication. The day commenced with a special assembly and prayer session. The Manager of the school, Rev. Fr. Thomas Appanchira CMI, inaugurated the new academic year, invoking blessings for a fruitful and successful journey ahead.

1. Academic Achievements

Carmel School, Chamba, achieved a 100% pass rate in the ICSE results for the academic year 2023-24. Master Pranay Juyal secured the highest score in Tehri Garhwal District with 97.8%. Aditi Negi secured the second position with 96.4%, while Ayush Chamoli attained the third position with 95.2%. Out of the 82 students who appeared for the examination, 16 students scored above 90%.

The students who appeared for the ISC Board examination also achieved spectacular results.

Master Rushil Gargash became the school topper in the Science stream, scoring 96%. He was followed by Kumari Shivangi and Vaibhavi Thapliyal, who both secured 92.5%.

In the Commerce stream, Master Anubhav Kothari secured the first position, followed by Kumari Sandhya Bhushan.

Our students also participated in Science, Maths, and GK Olympiads, winning cash awards and medals.

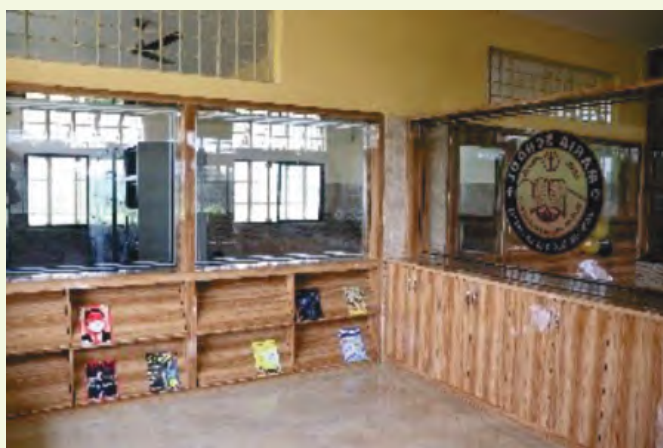
6. Special Highlights

❖ **Professional Development Programs (PDP) for Faculty**

1. Use of AI in Teaching-Learning at Sacred Heart College, Kochi.

❖ **Experiential Learning: Bridging Theory and Practice**

❖ **Hands-On Learning in Beekeeping**

Beehives were installed on campus to provide practical training in beekeeping and apiary management. This initiative helps students gain first hand experience in sustainable honey production and understand the environmental importance of pollinators.

❖ **Institutional Development Plan 2047**

The Institutional Development Plan 2047 was approved by the College Management Council, aiming for a Viksit SHDC by 2047, aligned with Viksit Bharat.

❖ **Fitness Thrust**

Uniting with the nation's FIT INDIA programme, the college has taken consistent steps to build up a fitness culture. An innovative step in this regard is the weekly fitness assembly, where a fitness protocol is introduced together with other forms of fitness exercises like Zumba. The Sports Committee and the Quality Assurance Cell oversee these initiatives.

❖ **Curriculum Enrichment**

- Value education is imparted through assemblies and special sessions by teachers on topics such as punctuality, friendship, service (seva), cleanliness, and respect for others.
- Cleanliness drives are conducted periodically through classes, departments, and NSS activities.
- A series on Indian Knowledge Systems was introduced, offering a certificate for a 1-credit course.
- N-LIST is used by teachers and students to enhance learning.

7. Staff Development and Welfare
